Sub: Provisional Regional Energy Accounting (REA) of Eastern Region for the month of April' 2011 for Chukha HPS, Kurichhu HPS, Tala HPS (Page No-8/11).

Sir,

Please refer to the issuance of Provisional Regional Energy Account (REA) for the month of April '11 issued vide this office letter No. ERPC/COM-I/REA/2011/736-775 dated 03.05.2011, excepting REA for Chukha HPS, Kurichhu HPS, Tala HPS (Page No-8/11) due to non-availability of meter reading data.

Upon receipt of requisite meter reading data, the REA for April'11 in respect of Chukha HPS, Kurichhu HPS, Tala HPS (Page No-8/11) is hereby prepared and issued.

Please find enclosed a copy of the Provisional Regional Energy Account for the month of April, 2011 (Page No-8/11) as above for further necessary action by the constituents.

It is to be informed that Kurichu HPS had imported energy through 132 KV Gelephu Salakati line for the months of February-11 and March-11[refer REA for month of Feb-11 and March-11]. Kurichu HPS has exported energy in April-11.

It was earlier informed that the energy imported by Bhutan through 132 KV Gelephu Salakati line would be adjusted with energy exported by Kurichu HPS subsequently. However, this adjustment against April-11 for energy imported in February-11 and March-11 would span two financial years, 2010-11 and 2011-12.

It is, therefore proposed, to adjust the energy imported by Bhutan through 132 KV Gelephu Salakati line along with the adjustment for import from 33 KV Tamulpur feeder and 11 KV Diafam feeder [for which meter reading were not available earlier], against Kurichu export for the year 2010-11 itself. Reconciliation statement giving details shall be issued by this office in 30 days.

Constituents are requested to intimate any discrepancy / error within two months from the date of issue of this provisional REA. In case of any discrepancy/error, the provisional REA would be revised based on re-examination, final decision and confirmation. In case no communication is received from any of the constituents indicating mistakes / discrepancy, the provisional REA as issued, would be treated as final.
